## **Submission Guidelines**

Prospective authors should send all material as a PDF by e-mail attachment to Melissa Meyer (mah300@psu.edu) by July 1, 2015. No mailed submissions will be considered. To allow for double-blind review, delete any identifying material from submitted manuscripts. Authors are free to use the manuscript style of their primary discipline (MLA, APA, etc.), with the exception that internal-text citation to a list of final references (bibliography) is required, in accordance with MLA or APA guidelines. There is no minimum page length requirement and short reports are welcomed; however, the maximum is 25 typed pages inclusive of references.
